

• 35 students achieved First Class with Distinction, indicating a high level of academic excellence among the students.


### 5. High Number of First Class Graduates:

• 51 students obtained Second Class, which still represents a satisfactory level of academic achievement.






The bar chart above visually represents the overall academic results for the year 2018-19 at Government Science College, Vankal.

The bar chart above visually represents the subject wise academic results for the year 2018-19 at Government Science College, Vankal.


### Result Outcomes for Academic Year 2019-20

- 7. **Failure Rate**: 52 students failed, suggesting areas where additional support and resources may be needed to improve future outcomes.




The bar chart above visually represents the overall academic results for the year 2019-20 at Government Science College, Vankal.






### **Result Outcomes for Academic Year 2021-22**

- 6. **Failure Rate**: 14 students failed, suggesting areas where additional support and resources may be needed to improve future outcomes.




The bar graph depicts the overall academic results for the academic year 2021-22 at Government Science College, Vankal.

The bar graph above illustrates the academic results for various subjects at Government Science College, Vankal for the academic year 2021-22.



- 6. **Failure Rate**: 28 students failed, suggesting areas where additional support and resources may be needed to improve future outcomes.




The bar graph depicts the overall academic results for the academic year 2022-23 at Government Science College, Vankal.
